Numurkah Solar Farm Community Fund Guidelines

Introduction

Numurkah Solar Farm (NMSF) is committed to contributing to the Moira Shire region by providing financial support to community groups to build capacity and grow the region. Numurkah Solar Farm commits to provide \$15,000 each calendar year to the Numurkah Solar Farm Community Fund to provide support to local projects that benefit and strengthen the Moira Shire region and align with certain community growth focus areas. Each year \$15,000 will be distributed to Projects through an open and competitive program.

Eligibility

Applications for grants between AU\$2,500 and AU\$10,000 will be awarded to projects:

- (a) Based on merit, skills and expertise and taking into account diverse representation of views and backgrounds. Numurkah Solar Farm will consider factors such as gender, abilities, age and cultural background; and
- (b) Which align with at least one of the following community growth areas:
 - (i) Environmental sustainability – inspiring participation, development and uptake of new technologies and ideas;
 - (ii) Health and wellbeing – contributing to improved health and wellbeing outcomes in regional communities;
 - (iii) Strong connected communities – community participation, involvement and connection;
 - (iv) Sport and recreation – increasing participation in sport and recreational activities;
 - (v) Arts and culture – fostering creativity and connection in the community through art and culture;
 - (vi) Skills, education and training – addressing local skills development and adding value to educational opportunities;

Ineligibility

- Events or activities that are deemed to be detrimental to the environment;
- Individuals;
- Councils or Section 86 Committees
- Political or military organisations or activities;
- Religious or sectarian organisations;
- Programs and projects outside of the community including international goodwill agencies; or
- Any person, organisation or project that is itself sanctioned or connected to any person that is sanctioned (directly or indirectly) under economic and trade sanctions imposed by Australia, the United States, the European Union or the United Nations, or will cause Numurkah Solar Farm Pty Ltd to breach any laws or regulations relating to anti-money laundering, counter-terrorism or economic and trade sanctions applicable in Australia or any other country.
